I would like to welcome you all to the 2022-23 school year! For those of you who are returning, welcome back! To those of you who are new to Lincoln Elementary, welcome to Our Pride! We are so excited to see you soon!

Some Important Dates to Start the Year:

- August 22: Student Orientation Conferences
- August 23: First Day of School (K-5)
- August 25: First Day of PK

Student Orientation Conferences provide an opportunity for students and families to meet their child's teacher and get important information about the school year. Sign-up times for student orientation conferences will be sent out via Parentsquare on **Monday, August 8**. Some drop-off and pick-up reminders for the upcoming school year:

- School begins each day at 8:15 AM (M-TH) and 9:15 AM (F). The school day ends at 3:00 PM each day. Each Friday we have a one hour late start for teacher professional development.
- Drop-off: We ask that all families drop students off at Lincoln Elementary between 7:45- 8:10 AM on Monday-Thursday and 8:45-9:10 AM on Fridays. There is no supervision on campus prior to these times and for safety ask that you do not drop students off before coverage begins.
- Breakfast and lunch are free to all Lincoln Elementary students. Breakfast will begin at 7:50 AM and end at 8:10 AM Monday-Thursday. Breakfast on late-start Fridays will begin at 8:50 and end at 9:10 AM.
- Traffic on Nevada Street: During pick-up and drop-off Nevada Street turns into a one-way street running north to south. When picking your student up or dropping off, please pull all the way to the curb. If there are no spaces available, we ask that you circle the block and come back. For the safety of all, please do not stop in the middle of the street. We appreciate your help with this!
