- Measures of Academic Progress, also known as MAP will be administered to students in grades 2-5 starting today and running thru Sept. 30. Students will take both a Reading and Math MAP assessment. Students take this test on a computer, and usually finish in about 45 minutes. We use the results to understand what students are ready to learn now. We also use the results to understand the impact of our instruction on students' learning. Parents/guardians will receive a written report of results as well.
