FREE 4-YEAR-OLD PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION

Registration for free four-year-old preschool in the Dubuque Community School District is now open. This includes Dubuque's 13 public schools offering preschool through the Statewide Voluntary Free Preschool Program.

Free four-year-old preschool is open to students who are four by September 15. Enrollment for preschool is not based on geography and all sites are open to lowa residents. Proof-of-age, preferably a birth certificate, is required to register a student. A passport or signed immunization record will be accepted if necessary. Initial paperwork can be found online at www.dbgschools.org/preschool or it is available in our office.

INFLUENZA UPDATE – From the Heath Office

Outbreaks of influenza (flu) and respiratory illness are common in the winter months and currently we are seeing widespread activity in our area. Students and staff may be able to infect each other one day before symptoms occur and up to ten days after being sick. In an effort to help reduce the transmission and potential outbreaks of influenza parents and school staff need to be aware of the symptoms of the flu and what they need to do.

SYMPTOMS OF FLU INCLUDE:

Fever (usually high), headache, extreme tiredness, dry cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle aches, stomach symptoms, such as nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea, also can occur but are more common in children than adults Children and adults displaying any of these symptoms should stay home until they are fever free (without the use of medication to reduce the fever) for 24 hours, and free from vomiting and diarrhea for 24 hours.

HOW TO PREVENT THE FLU

- Get vaccinated for influenza
- Teach and encourage good handwashing and wash hands regularly with warm water and soap for at least 15-20 seconds before and after eating, recess, gym class and every other situation involving frequent child to child interaction. Parents and staff can be good role models.
- Use hand sanitizers only in areas when soap and water are not readily available.
