With the weather, becoming warmer our children are getting outside more and now would be a good time to review outdoor safety. Here are a few tips to get you started

1. Make safety checks, it is important to make sure the location is physically safe and age appropriate.
2. Don't skip on the SPF!
3. Cool clothes, cool play
4. Keep the H2O handy
5. Take a break
6. Snack smart
7. Teach street safety
8. Teach stranger safety and unsafe places
9. Games and bicycle safety
10. Show your children safe spots.
