Mrs. Kaiser's Counselor Corner

During the week of December 7th - 11th I have been in grades 3 thru 5 covering communication skills. In third grade we reviewed the story Snake, Snail and Smiley Self and introduced the terminology aggressive, passive and assertive. In fourth grade we reviewed the characteristics of an aggressive, passive or assertive person. The students took an assertive quiz to see what skills they already utilize and which ones they could learn to incorporate in their lives. In fifth grade we watched a short video and the students had to determine which characters were displaying aggressive, passive or assertive

skills. Students were then put into small groups where they were given a short skit that they had to role play and the class had to guess if they were being aggressive, passive or assertive during their skits. Next week I will be working in small groups.
