During the week of December 5th – 9th I have been in grades kindergarten thru second. In kindergarten we watched a video about keeping our hands to ourselves. The students then did a smart board activity where they had to decide if it was ok to go inside someone's bubble or if they were being a bubble buster. In first grade we read the story Snake, Snail and Best Self. We discussed the story and what characteristics each character portrayed in the story. Students also drew a picture of themselves as their best self and shared with the class. In second grade we reviewed the characteristics of Snake, Snail and Best Self. Students then did a smart board activity where they had to put a behavior in the correct category of snake, snail or best self. Next week I will continue to work on communication skills with third thru fifth grade.
