## Mrs. Kaiser's Counselor Corner

During the week of February 8th – 12th Mr. Nate Tyler from the Riverview center has been in discussing body safety with all grades. Childhelp's new and enhanced 21st Century abuse prevention program is an evolution of the Childhelp Good Touch Bad Touch<sup>TM</sup> (GTBT) program delivered in schools nationally since 1983. Childhelp Speak Up Be Safe is a research based, comprehensive primary prevention education curriculum that equips children in Grades 1-6 and their adult community with skills they need to play a significant role in the prevention or

interruption of physical, emotional, and sexual abuse, neglect. The school based curriculum utilized web-based tools, focusing on building selfesteem and safety skills within the child, to include addressing today's societal risks children encounter everyday such as internet and cell phone safety. The curriculum redirects focus on the adult's responsibility and skill building by engaging the states, schools, facilitators, teachers, parents and designated safe adults in the protection of our children. The program also focuses on meeting state standards for health, and safety education, which allows a complementary curriculum based approach for this issue.
