Mrs. Kaiser's Counselor Corner

During the month of February our focus will remain on body safety. As you know Nate Tyler from Riverview was in last week with all grades discussing this subject matter. One message that the students learned was that their bodies belong to them. All students were encouraged to say "no" when they don't want to be touched. Students were also encouraged to develop a safety network. This would involve 5 trusted adults that they can tell anything to and they would believe them.

We also focused on what is an appropriate secret to keep and when we should tell a trusted adult in our safety network. Also, in the grades K-2 private parts were discussed. All students received that same message of what private parts are, no one is allowed to touch my private parts, no one should ask me to touch their private parts and no one should show me pictures of private parts. If this should happen I should tell a trusted adult in my safety network. Next week Mr. Dyer and I will be meeting with grades 4 and 5 to discuss digital literacy

and what steps students should take if on the internet and they receive inappropriate information.
