My 2J school success group has started to learn about the difference between a fixed mindset and a growth mindset. 3W has continued to learn about the growth mindset and how to show their classmates how to utilize this technique. Next week Mr. Nate Tyler from Riverview will be visiting all grades talking about body safety. The curriculum is called Speak Up Be Safe. It is considered the most current "best practices" curriculum available for this subject matter according to the Iowa Coalition Against Sexual Assault and is endorsed by the Center for Disease Control Prevention Education Division.
