During the week of January 29th – February 1st I have been in kindergarten thru second grade. The focus this month is on protective behaviors. In kindergarten, we watched a video about red and green touch and discussed the importance of using the correct terminology when pertaining to our private parts. Kindergarten students also learned our **No, Go, Yell, Tell** phrase. In first grade, we reviewed red and green touch but also introduced a new touch, yellow touch. First grade students learned that a yellow touch is a confusing touch and to use the phrase **No, Go, Yell, Tell!** In second grade, we reviewed red, green and yellow touch but also discussed what an instinct is. When our body gives us clues or warning signs that something may be wrong we should use our **No, Go, Yell, Tell** phrase. Next week I will be in grades 3-5.
