During the week of January 30th – February 3rd I have been in kindergarten thru second grade. Our focus for the month of February is body safety and protective behaviors. In kindergarten we watched a video about body safety and learned the #1 rule for body safety, NO, GO, YELL, TELL! In first grade we reviewed our body safety rule and did a smart board activity on green, yellow and red touch. We really focused on yellow touches and how these touches can be confusing. In second grade we reviewed green, yellow and red touch and read the book *A Terrible Thing Happened*. The book talks about using our instincts to prevent us from getting into trouble. Next week I will be working with third thru fifth grade on body safety and protective behaviors.

Tips for Parents: Ask your children what they learned in Guidance class on body safety. As a district we encourage them to use the medical term for their private parts. Give your child a couple of scenarios and ask, what would you do?
