Counselor Corner...Mrs. Kaiser

During the week of February 5th-9th. I have been in grades 3-5. The focus this month is on protective behaviors. In third grade, we reviewed red, yellow and green touch and what is an instinct. All students listened to the book, *Some Secrets Should Never Be Kept*. We then discussed our no, go, yell, tell rule and which trusted adults they could report to. In fourth grade, we discussed internet safety. Some internet safety tips included; keeping your personal information personal, what people shouldn't be asking you online and that you may not be talking to whom you think you are chatting with. In fifth grade, Mr. Dyer and I teach a cyberbullying lesson. We discuss your digital footprint, what to do if you are being cyberbullied and why do they think there is an age limit for some of the apps/websites they utilize. Next week I will be working with small groups.
