We are starting to get some confirmed cases of influenza so we will be implementing the following guidelines again for this cold and flu season. This information is also available on the website in Health Services:

Along with the recommendation that all staff and students receive the flu vaccine, the Dubuque Community School District will start the implementation of not returning to school until free from fever (greater than or equal to 101 F), diarrhea or vomiting without the use of medications for 24 hours to help reduce the spread of germs that cause diarrhea, colds and influenza. In addition, we will be reminding staff and students of the importance of good handwashing.

Clean Hands Saves Lives

Handwashing is like a "do-it-yourself" vaccine—it involves five simple and effective steps (Wet, Lather, Scrub, Rinse, Dry) you can take to reduce the spread of diarrheal and respiratory illness so you can stay healthy. Regular handwashing, particularly before and after certain activities, is one of the best ways to remove germs, avoid getting sick, and prevent the spread of germs to others. It's quick, it's simple, and it can keep us all from getting sick. Handwashing is a win for everyone, except the germs.

Counselor Corner...Mrs. Kaiser

During the week of January 22-26th, I have been working with all of my small groups with the focus on having a growth mindset. We have been using the book, <u>Your</u> <u>Fantastic Elastic Brain Stretch It</u>, <u>Shape It</u>. Last week we focused on the five parts of the brain, the cerebrum, hippocampus, prefrontal cortex, amygdala and the cerebellum. We also focused on the importance of neurons in the brain. This week we are training our brains to use growth mindset phrases. Students were given several growth mindset statements and picked their favorite one. We then discussed what part of their day they could use their growth mindset statement. Each student will be keeping tallies for me to show every time they trained their brains to use a growth mindset statement. Next week I will be in kindergarten thru second grade.
