During the week of January 3rd – 5th, I have been working with kindergarten thru second grade. During the week of January, we will be focusing on self-regulation. In kindergarten, the students learned about self-control. They watched a short video of Cookie Monster displaying self-control and all students were tested on this as well. We did an activity where they could not pop bubbles when it was their turn; they all did a terrific job! In first grade, we did the activity bag of feelings. Two students would act out a feeling and the audience would try to guess that feeling. The new learning for first grade is the awareness that not everyone feels the same way even if they have the same experience. In second grade, we did the activity bug bag. The students talked about scenarios that bugged them and defined and made a list of coping skills that would help them when they are feeling bugged. Next week I will be in grades 3 - 5.
