In third grade we watched a video about children who attend grief camp and discussed the purpose of a wake/funeral/visitation. In fourth grade we watched another grief camp video and made a memory handprint with coping skills we can utilize when we lose a loved one. In fifth grade we talked about the grief cycle and how this cycle can feel like you are riding a roller coaster. We also shared different coping skills you can utilize during each stage.
