During the week of March 12th – 16th, I have been in grades 3 thru 5. This month we are continuing to focus on life changes and loss. In third grade, we watched a short video of children at a grief camp and how they utilized various coping skills through the stages of grief. In fourth grade, we watched a young girl who lost her dad during his deployment and how she used her coping skills. Each student traced their hand and listed what coping skills they would use during grief. In fifth grade, all students learned the five stages of grief (denial, anger, bargaining, depression and acceptance) and related it to the movie, Finding Nemo. Next week I will be working with small groups.
