During the week of November 16th – 20th I have been working with small groups. In my third grade competitive group we took a quiz to see if we think dominantly with our left or right brain. Once we knew if we were a right or left brain thinker we then shared how we like to do things and why this may be important to us. We also discussed why it may be difficult for us to work in groups with peers that think differently than we do; the students also discussed some strategies to get through a conflict if we disagree with a peer.
