# Counselor Corner-Mrs. Kaiser

During the week of October 12th – 16th I have been in grades 3 thru 5. We have continued to work on conflict resolution during the month of October. In third grade the students watched a video on different types of bullying and what skills they can utilize if it is happening to them or if they witness it happening to others. They also learned the definition of bullying, passive bystander, active bystander and upstander. In fourth grade the students watched the bullying video and reviewed key concepts. They also learned the definition of harassment and what the DCSD policy is on bullying and harassment. In fifth grade the students watched the bullying video and reviewed key concepts. We reviewed the DCSD policy and the legal systems policy on bullying and harassment. Next week I will be working with small groups.
