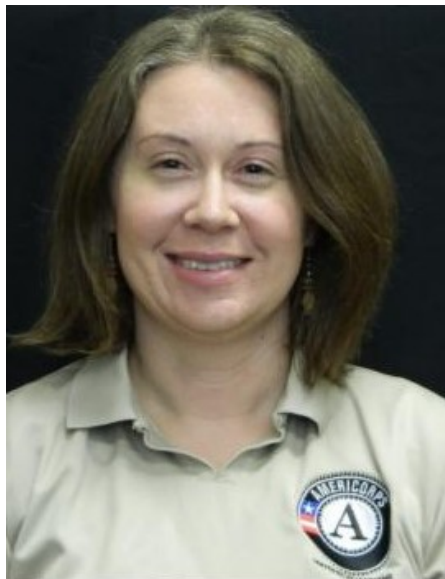

During the week of September 12th – 16th I have been in third thru fifth grade focusing on skills for learning. In third grade we discussed how they can put forth effort in relation to school. Each student made a school goal that they will be putting effort towards, made a plan of how and when they will achieve their goal. In fourth grade we focused on the importance of attendance (physically and mentally) and putting forth effort to be successful now and in the future. In fifth grade we talked about time management.
