This will be on the ballot for the election on **Tuesday, September 12 from 7 a.m.-8 p.m.** School Board positions will also be on the ballot this election. The current levy expires on June 30, 2019, and requires approval every 10 years. The levy is being placed on the ballot during this year's election to minimize the cost of having a special election next year when no school board elections are scheduled to be held.
