## Open Enrollment Time for the 2018-2019 School Year

If you do not live in the Bryant School boundaries and would like to attend Bryant next year, you **MUST** complete an Open Enrollment form with the district. This year, all forms must be completed online. Paper copies will not be accepted. Beginning on March 15, the online application process begins and ends on May 1. You can locate the form by going to [www.dubuqueschools.org](http://www.dubuqueschools.org) and follow the open enrollment link. If you need help with accessing a computer, locating the form, or completing the form, you are encouraged to call our office. Remember that an Open Enrollment form must be completed **each year**. If you do not complete a form, it is assumed that you are returning to your home school, and your child's records will be sent there at the end of the school year.

## Updated Information

If you have had any changes in name, address, phone numbers, emails, or emergency contacts, it is critical that you either **update your PowerSchool account** or call the school office. Without accurate information, we are unable to contact you in an emergency or get information to you in a timely manner. We are having critical information returned because an address that we have listed is no longer correct or emails are not accurate.
