Playground Use

With the nice weather, it is great to see our playground being used in the evenings and on the weekends. Please remember that **the playground is open to the public beginning at 4:00pm on school nights**. The sign on the playground fence indicates the times that the playground may be used by the public. All students and families should leave the playground after dismissal.

There is a gap between dismissal time and opening the playground to the public for safety reasons and to accommodate after-school activities. With this policy, we are able to make sure that children leave for home, our YCare program can utilize the playground and be able to safely supervise students, and Leisure Service Programs such as the track program may use the playground for their practice.

We appreciate your help in leaving the playground right after dismissal and are happy to open the playground back up to the neighborhood at 4:00 pm.
