

Progress Reports

Hard to believe that we are already one-third of the way through the school year. This year, the DCSD is sharing student progress in a new way. All progress reports will be available to you electronically through PowerSchool. In fact, at ANY TIME you have access to view your student's grades. As students take assessments, their grades will be available to you.

Two Different Student Reports

Pilot Classes for new Progress Report

If your child is in Mrs. Hull or Mrs. Steuer's kindergarten class, Mrs. Obberhoffer's first grade class, or Mrs. Leach and Ms. Funke's third grade class, your child will receive the new Standards Report that is being piloted across the district. In this report, you will see which end of the year standard your child has already met. Since not all standards have been tested yet, not all standards will be marked. As assessments for the standards are given, you will see the standard identified as met or not met. No indication with a standard means that this standard has not yet been assessed.

You already have received information regarding how to access grades online and can print at any time.

Traditional Progress Report

All classes except for the four classes in the pilot will be graded in the traditional manner using the B, N, M, and E marks. The classes that use the traditional report will receive a grade each trimester that will indicate their progress. Although the grading is the same, the report will have a new look. This is the transition of format from the transitional report this year to what the format will look like next year when the grading changes.

You should have already received an email and phone call from the district explaining the new process for accessing progress reports. Today an informational letter regarding the specifics of how to access the information will be in your child's folder. **You are able to access the progress reports beginning on Monday, November 20th! We are hoping that most parents utilize the ability to access the report through PowerSchool. We will no longer automatically print progress reports each trimester.** If you should desire a hard copy of the report, you can print the report from home at any time. If you need assistance to access the progress report, our office staff can help.

Changes can be challenging and exciting at the same time. As everyone moves toward the new Standards Report next year, parents will be able to identify specifically which grade level standards their child has met and which ones still need to be addressed. The information that parents will receive is much more detailed. As we work through this transition, please do not hesitate to call school if you have any questions.

Once the data has been compiled and analyzed by the district, goals will be established to move us forward in using technology as an integral component of our instructional programming.
