
BFO Sponsored Cookie Walk

Safety Drill

Each year, all schools provide instruction to students regarding what to do in case of an emergency. This practice helps to prepare students in the event that the school would ever need to lock down for safety, should there be an intruder or some other unsafe situation within the school. All K through 5 students will participate in the lesson within their classroom to teach these safety precautions. The district has created a common lesson for teachers to use that is accompanied by an age- appropriate video that is used in the elementary schools. The discussion is handled in the same type of manner as safety lessons for fire and severe weather. All classes at Bryant will teach the lesson during the first two weeks of January.



Winter Weather

Winter has finally arrived. Please make sure that your child dresses appropriately for the weather. All students have outdoor recess unless the wind chill is below zero. If the wind chill is below zero prior to the start of school, staff will place a cone on the playground by the gym door indicating that students may enter the gym. Staff will monitor the lines and welcome students into the gym. Students must wear boots if they are going to leave the blacktop. Younger students must also have snow pants if they are going to play in the field or on the equipment. If you are in need of winter clothing for your child, please call our school nurse or counselor.
