Winter MAP Testing

The district always wants to maximize instructional time for students and teachers. We continually examine our practices to see if there are ways to increase instructional time. This year, there was a district-wide conversation about winter MAP testing. Historically, students in grades 2-5 all participated in the winter MAP assessment. After much discussion, it was decided that for <u>many</u> students, the information gained through this mid-year test was information that teachers already knew or had access to in different ways. This is not a state required assessment, and it was decided that schools would determine their own plan for assessment.

Since, for students in grades 3-5, we have ITP as another assessment and students have taken the MAP assessment previously, we feel as though we have enough assessment data on MOST of the children and therefore, will not administer the assessment this winter. We will administer the assessment again this spring. There are a few students for whom we may need additional assessment information, and those students will be tested on an individualized basis.

Since 2nd grade does not yet take ITP and only has taken MAP once, we did feel as though the information gained through this winter testing can provide further insights about the students, and we can best match our teaching strategies with our learner's needs. Both 2nd grade classes will be taking the winter MAP assessment.

Preschool Registration for 2018-2019

It is hard to believe, but planning for the 2018-2019 school year has begun! Registration for the DCSD preschools will be held on **Monday, February 5th at 7:00 am.** All preschools across our district will host registration on this day.

There are only two requirements for your child to attend the Free Four-Year Old program:

- 1. Your child must be 4 on or before September 15th, 2018
- 2. Your child must be a resident of Iowa

You may register your child for any preschool program within the district: there are no specific attendance boundaries. Although Bryant would love to have your child attend here if this is your homeschool for kindergarten but, there are a limited number of slots for preschool at each school. Attending Bryant may not be possible. Even if your child will not be able to attend Bryant, don't miss out on this wonderful experience. Every school will offer a great beginning to our young learners.

The doors for registration will not open until 7:00 a.m. at all schools so that all families have equal opportunity to register. Openings will be filled on a first-come basis. You may go on to the district website to obtain the forms for registration. Complete the forms and bring them with you to registration. This will speed up the time that it takes for enrollment on February 5th. Enrollment papers may not be accepted early.

To register your child, please make sure that you bring along your child's birth certificate for proof of age. We also can accept passports or signed immunization certificates. <u>Students cannot be registered until</u> <u>there is proof of age.</u>
