We have many exciting things happening in second grade! Students are learning about the life cycles of plants and insects.

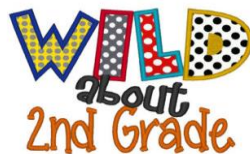
We are studying Brassica, Darkling Beetles, Painted Lady Butterflies, and Milkweed Bugs.

Students are enthusiastically observing the changes that take place and recording the information in science journals.

We are studying seasons and weather in reading, and each reading group is learning more about extreme types of weather.

Two-digit addition has been our focus in math. Students are exploring a variety of strategies to solve double digit problems. These include making pictures, using base ten pieces, estimating, using the two-hundreds chart, and solving problems using the traditional paper pencil method. Second graders have been very busy with all their new learning.
