### Principal's Corner

**Morning Arrival Time:** Please be sure that your children DO NOT arrive to school prior to 8:25 a.m. as there is no supervision until that time. Students are learning about numbers and patterns on a 200 chart, graphing, and how to create and solve number sentences in math. We began our science unit on solids and liquids and learned about the three different types of communities in social studies. Second grade is looking forward to a great year of learning!
