## Picture Re-Take Day

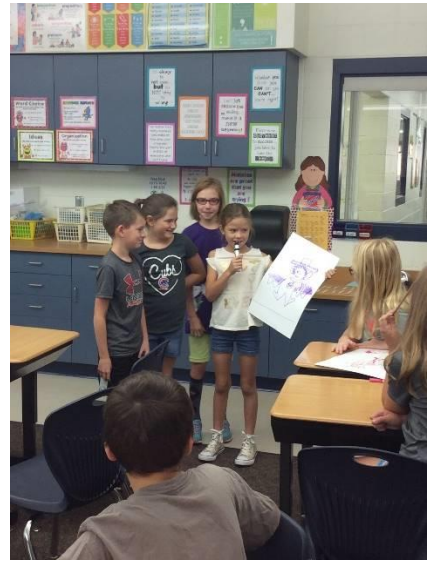
Monday, November 20th is re-take day. Please send your picture package to school if you wish to have them retaken. If your child missed the first picture day, they will also have their photo taken.
