#### **NEW PROCEDURES FOR PICKING STUDENTS UP WHEN ILL**

Over the past few months, we have initiated a new procedure for picking up your student from the health office when they are ill and need to go home. You may now pick them up directly from the health office by coming into the lower parking lot off JFK (where the bus turn-around is). There is a sign by the dumpster that says: FOR PICK UP AND DROP OFF ONLY. You may park in that spot and come into the doors under the canopy area to sign your child out. There will be a buzzer by the door to notify the health office staff that you are here so they can open the door for you. The health office is located just inside the doors across from the staircase. Of course, you may always come to the main office as before to pick your child off when ill, however by using the new procedure, you will be able to speak with the nurse or health para directly with any questions or concerns.
