## School Principal News! ~Mr. Ferguson

Welcome to the 2017-18 school year! Now that we are in the third week of school, it feels like summer is a distant memory and the routine of work and school has returned. I enjoy being on a schedule and in a routine and I hope you agree that it is great to be back to school and into a "school routine". I also hope that your child(ren) are off to a great school year! It's been one of the smoothest and best beginnings of school that I can remember!

As we move forward with the school year, here are a couple reminders as it pertains to student safety: We have staff supervision on the playground area and safety patrol in the morning starting at 8:15 a.m. Students should NOT be at school before 8:15 unless they are going to Y-care or the breakfast program (which starts at 8:00). When students arrive before 8:15, there is no supervision and with that a greater chance for problems to occur. If you need an earlier arrival, please contact Y-Care to line up childcare arrangements. Thanks for your cooperation. Our entry bell isn't until 8:25 and our tardy bell at 8:35 so students have plenty of time to get to class when dropped off no sooner than 8:15. Thanks for your help on this!

Arrival and dismissal time: To help keep this running smoothly, please adhere to our parking lot arrival and dismissal procedures. In the morning, please pull into the lot and pull around as far as you can and let your child(ren) exit your vehicle on the sidewalk side of your car only. Do not stop and let children out in the driveway area. They will then be able to follow the sidewalk around to their lineup area. Please do not use the driveway or pull up area to park your vehicle. If you need to park, utilize a parking spot or park on the street and take advantage of our crosswalk patrol workers. After school, pull into the pickup zones and wait for your child in your vehicle unless you are using a parking spot. Staff will work to ensure your child is escorted to your vehicle safely. Drivers, be VERY mindful of our little ones by watching carefully and driving SLOWLY whenever you are in our parking lots.

If you are dropping your child off in the neighborhood, please be sure to utilize our safety patrol staff at the corner of Spring Valley and Olde Country Lane as well as at the crosswalk light on JFK. Never let your child out in the middle of the street, especially on JFK, and please don't cross in the middle of the street. Pull over to park so your child can exit your vehicle on the sidewalk side of your car and then walk down to a crosswalk area. If you are dropping off on JFK, please pull into one of the church parking lots and then utilize the crosswalk where there is a controlled light and a safety patrol staff member. Our students are observing adults and when they see adults do something unsafe like cross in the middle of the street, they think it's ok for them to do it too which creates dangerous situations. Thanks for your cooperation in keeping our students safe!

Near the end of the month, we have our fall reading assessment (week of September 18) for all grades K-5 followed by MAP testing taking place sometime from September 25-October 13. Results will be shared with you at conferences.

If you have any questions for me, feel free to give a call to school or stop by and see me in the main office. Thanks for a great start to the school year. We are glad to have your children at Eisenhower where we are AWESOME!
